Preparing for Graduation

Check your eligibility

To be eligible to graduate you must have completed all course requirements and student fees need to be up to date. If you are concerned about your eligibility you can speak to your teachers and they can advise what you need to do.

Registration

Finishing your course doesn't mean you are automatically registered to attend a graduation ceremony. If you would like to attend a ceremony, you will need to register.

What do I do if I do not know my USI and student number?

Please call 1300 308 233, student services will be able to assist you.

What if I didn't pass my studies?

If this happens and you have already registered and paid to attend you will be entitled to a full refund. You will need to make contact with TAFE Queensland at least 24 hours prior to the ceremony after this time a refund will not be possible.

If you are unsure if you are going to pass your qualification, speak to your teacher.

Helpful hints

- 1. **Stay Hydrated** this is our hottest time of year, drink plenty of water.
- 2. **Don't be late** there is a lot to do prior to the ceremony including registration, robing, photos and briefing
- 3. Keep hold of your sticker given to you at registration. This will assist us in helping to announce your name correctly when you are called out on stage as well as making sure you are in the correct seating order.
- 4. You are responsible for your academic regalia. You will sign for the academic regalia at the time of robing and sign again upon returning the items. Failing to return the academic regalia will incur a fee for the replacement of these items.
- 5. **Keep an eye out** for further emails and communications regarding your graduation.

Gowning

Diploma and above graduands will wear traditional academic regalia, black gown, mortarboard and appropriate sash over their clothes. Please be mindful of hairstyles and how these will be affected when wearing the mortar board.

Dress code

All graduating students and guests are asked to wear semi-formal attire. Please note: jeans, thongs, sneakers and similar casual items are not appropriate attire for graduation ceremonies.

Arrival time

Registration opens at 4.00pm this will allow graduates enough time to register and be gowned (if diploma) and have photos taken.

Registration and robing closes at 4.30pm sharp.

Seating arrangements

You will be allocated a seat number upon registration. Please do not swap seats with other graduands as this is the order you will be called out of your seat to appear on stage. You are required to attend a student briefing at 4.40pm sharp. This briefing will go for approximately 10 minutes, upon conclusion guests will be seated in time for a 5.00pm starting time. All students must be ready to enter the theatre/venue at 4.40pm. Please follow directions of ceremony staff at all times.

Friends and family will sit separately to graduating students. You will be able to join them again at the conclusion of the official ceremony.

Photography

We encourage photos and videos during the ceremony but ask that guests be mindful of other guests and ask that they re-frame from leaving their seats. You can share pictures on social media #tafegrad2019

Guest information

Guests are invited to arrive between 4.00pm and 4.30pm. Guests are asked to please present their email confirmation. Please note there is no allocated guest seating. Guest will be seated at 4.50pm, 10 minutes prior to the start of the ceremony. During the ceremony, graduands and guests are asked not to leave the auditorium unless necessary to minimise disruption to other students and guests.
