



MIMS / Guild Intern of the Year Award 2020

Terms and Conditions

- These terms and conditions apply to all nominators and all entrants into the MIMS / Guild Intern of the Year Award 2020 (the **Competition**).
- Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these conditions. Entry into this Competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions of entry.
- The promoter is The Pharmacy Guild of Australia ABN 84 519 669 143 whose registered office is located at 132 Leichhardt Street, Spring Hill, QLD, 4000 (**PGA**).

Overview of the Competition

- Eligible nominator nominates eligible entrant for the Competition during the nomination period
- Eligible entrant accepts that nomination by completing a submission package
- Eligible entries will be judged by an independent panel; and
- Competition winner will be announced, and the prize will be awarded, at the APP conference
 2021.

Nomination process

Who can nominate a candidate?

- Candidates for the Competition can be nominated by:
 - o supervising preceptors;
 - o employers;
 - o a pharmacist or other pharmacy colleague;
 - o a PGA Intern Training Program clinical tutor; or
 - o themselves,

(Eligible Nominators).

Who can be nominated?

- This Competition is strictly limited to PGA interns who:
 - o have successfully completed (or are due to complete) the PGA Intern Training Program during the 2020 calendar year; and
 - \circ are aged 18 years and over at the time of their nomination ,

(Eligible Entrants).

When can I nominate an Eligible Entrant?

• Eligible Nominators can nominate Eligible Entrants between Monday 26 October 2020 and Friday 12 March 2021 (Nomination Period).





- There is no entry fee and purchase required in order to nominate an Eligible Entrant for, or for an Eligible Entrant to accept a nomination for, entry into the Competition.
- Nominations received outside of the Nomination Period will not be considered.

How do I nominate an Eligible Entrant?

- To nominate an Eligible Entrant for the Competition, an Eligible Nominator must:
 - o Complete the nomination form available at: http://ems.gs/3kFojlcFXy
- There is no limit to the number of Eligible Entrants that an Eligible Nominator can nominate.

Once an Eligible Entrant has been nominated: accepting a nomination

- Once PGA receives a nomination of an Eligible Entrant from an Eligible Nominator that conforms in
 all respects with these terms and conditions (each an Eligible Entry), PGA will notify the Eligible
 Entrant in writing via email of their nomination. That notification will include a link to the submission
 form (Submission Form).
- All nominated Eligible Entrants must formally accept their nomination by completing a Submission
 Form by Friday 12 March 2021 via the online submission form at: http://ems.gs/3kFojdcFXK. Any
 Submission Forms received after this date will not be accepted, and the nomination of that Eligible
 Entrant for the Competition will not be considered.

Judging

How is the competition **judged**?

- All Eligible Entries will be judged by an independent adjudicator or panel of judges appointed by PGA, and one winner will be selected. This is a game of skill only and chance plays no part in determining the winner.
- Eligible Entries will be judged according to the ability to demonstrate an exceptional level of achievement in one of the five following criteria:
 - o Patient-centred practice
 - Improving the health of communities
 - Innovative pharmacy practice
 - o Integrity, honesty & professionalism
 - Teamwork, communication & reliability
 - o Response to the COVID-19 pandemic
- The outcome of the Competition is final and binding.

The award

What is the award?

- The winning Eligible Entry will receive:
 - o a \$4,500 cash bursary





o return flights, up to the value of \$900, three nights accommodation and one Full Registration including Street Party for APP2021 for the official award presentation,¹ (the Award)

Notification and **acceptance** of the Award

- The winner of the Competition will be notified in writing and by telephone, and the winner's name will be published on PGA's website (at www.internpharmacist.com.au). If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the Award within 14 days of notification by PGA, PGA can withdraw the Award from the winner and redistribute the Award at its absolute discretion.
- PGA will notify the winner when and where the Award can be collected.
- The winner must be available to travel to the Gold Coast, Queensland to accept the Award at the APP Conference (currently, 20-23 May 2021).

Privacy and intellectual property

- All Eligible Entrants:
 - o consent to PGA using and disclosing their personal information for any purpose in connection with the Competition;
 - consent to the use of his/her name and image in any material, including promotional material (Material) in connection with the Competition and without any compensation to the Eligible Entrant;
