

Eligibility Criteria

1. The fellowship is open to all RHD students enrolled through CHRC and those who have a Primary Advisor located within CHRC.
2. The fellowship will provide up to \$3,000 towards travel costs to present at a conference and undertake networking opportunities.
3. The funds will assist in costs associated with attending a conference, but the travel must also involve a component of further networking. For example, presenting at an academic institution, visiting a hospital or industry company, with the purpose of seeking future post-doctoral or collaborative opportunities.
4. Students can apply at any time of the year.
5. Approximately 5 fellowships will be available each calendar year.
6. Successful applicants are not eligible to apply for subsequent travel fellowships through this scheme.
7. Preference is given to those in the final year of their candidature, as these fellowships are viewed as a means to further the student's post-doctoral opportunities.
8. It is essential that the student is presenting a talk or poster at the conference although it is understood an abstract may not have been accepted at the time of application. Confirmation of abstract acceptance is required prior to distribution of money.
9. A curriculum vitae (CV), must be provided with the application, as would be used for a post-doctoral position application.
10. Travel should take place within 6 months from the submission date, however variations to this will be considered if justified within the application.
11. All awardees are expected to report upon return from the travel, detailing the benefits of having attended the conference and their engagement activities whilst on this Fellowship.
