2. If (X) is indicated for any competency you **MUST** support this with written reasons in the space at the bottom of the page.

The candidate demonstrates to a high level of competency, the ability to:

- ☐ Talk in appropriate canine terminology
- ☐ Understand anatomical construction relevant to each breed
- ☐ Approach and examine a dog correctly and appropriately for each breed
- ☐ Mouth a dog correctly
- ☐ Interpret a breed standard by correctly describing breed characteristics and consistently recognising correct breed type
- ☐ Evaluate and recognise correct balance for each breed, and how this relates to individual breed function.
- ☐ Assess and recognise correct structure for each breed, and explain how this relates to specific breed gait/movement
- ☐ Control, organise and use the judging ring effectively
- ☐ Make decisions in an effective way and in an effective time frame
- ☐ Correctly examine and critique using breed specific language
- ☐ Justify placings in both Breed and Group judging
- ☐ Dress appropriately and conduct themselves in an acceptable manner
